

High Point Elks Swimming Pool Letter for the 2025 Season

Dear Member,

Can you believe it! The summer season is almost here, and everybody is looking forward to another great pool year. Included in this letter are all the things “you need to know”. Through this letter and attachments, we hope to communicate information regarding hours, rules, and any changes for this year so that every Member has a safe and enjoyable time at the pool.

Our opening day will be Friday, May 23rd at 5pm (pool closes at 9pm). We will have our traditional opening day FREE Hot Dog Cookout beginning at 6pm. **You are encouraged to bring a prospective Member as guests of pool Members are FREE opening weekend (Friday, Saturday and Sunday).** No in town guests are allowed on Memorial Day. The pool will remain open through Labor Day, September 1st.

We look forward to a great time at the Pool this year. There will be plenty of planned activities (School’s Out Cookout, 4th of July, Labor Day, Cornhole & Bocce Ball Tournaments, etc.) and an exciting Swim Team season.

Guests may be required to wear wristbands which must remain on during their visit. Reminder, each individual guest is only allowed to visit 3 times per season.

The entire pool deck and shelter areas are NON-SMOKING / NON-VAPING / NON-E-CIGARETTES.

Enclosed you will find registration cards for you and your family to be completed as instructed. We invite all Members in good standing who are current with Lodge Dues to join the pool. Due to rising costs for utilities, pool management, equipment and supplies we are increasing pool dues \$5 to \$100 per person. Children of pool Members under the age of 2 on June 1st are free. Guest fees will be \$15 per person per visit. We also offer the 10 visit guest card for \$125. This card can only be purchased by a paid pool member and will be available from the Lodge office. Lockers are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Rental cost is \$5 for the season. Locker numbers and combinations will be provided by the Lifeguards.

Lifeguards WILL NOT be allowed to collect any membership fees at the pool. Payments can be made at the Lodge office Monday thru Friday 10am - 2pm. Pool cards will be available upon your first visit to the pool with proper identification.

Please note that in order to use the pool opening weekend **you must have your Lodge Dues current and Pool Dues paid by 1pm on Friday, May 23rd.** There will be nobody to collect dues until the following Tuesday, **May 27th.** All major credit cards are accepted for pool dues/fees.

On weekdays, when Guilford County Schools (GCS) are in session, through the last day of school and starting again on the first day of the following school year – pool hours are abbreviated. **The pool closes at 4pm for home swim meets.** Home swim meet dates will be posted on our website once they are finalized. Pool closings could vary depending on weather conditions and/or number of people using the pool. Early closing, if any, will be at the discretion of the Pool Committee.

Alcoholic beverages may be purchased from the Lounge. **No alcoholic beverages may be brought to the pool at any time (unless purchased in Lodge Lounge).** *Any infraction could result in our ABC license being revoked.*

Summary of Swimming Pool Regulations for the 2025 Season

All eligible persons must be listed on pool card for admittance. Those eligible for admission and to use the pool:

- Members in good standing with this Lodge, and/or their spouse and their unmarried children under the age of 25 that are living in the Member's home.
- An unmarried member can have as his/her guest a girl/boyfriend and his/her unmarried children under the age of 25. Exceptions only as are otherwise provided in these rules.
- **The Member will be responsible for any person on their card as well as any person signed in by a person on their card.**

Members will use their Elk pool card and a photo id for admittance to the pool. You will pick up your pool card upon your first visit to the pool with proper identification. Spouse and/or children of Elks will show their pool card and sign in, and members will sign their guests in at the front desk. You will receive 2 cards in this mailing. Additional cards can be purchased \$5 for members on your card that are 16 and over. These must be purchased through the Lodge office.

- All members, spouses, children and guests must sign in upon entering the pool.
- Out of county (other than Davidson, Randolph, Guilford and Forsyth) overnight houseguests shall be admitted at any time during regular hours. Normal guest fees apply unless otherwise noted.
- **Admission fee for each Guest is \$15.** Guests must be registered at the front desk and may be required to wear the supplied wristbands at all times while in pool area. **Members are responsible for their guests. Guests must leave when the sponsoring Member leaves the Lodge grounds.**
- An individual Guest may only be allowed 3 times per pool season.
- Limit of 3 (three) guests per member on a given day, unless otherwise approved or as part of a shelter party.
- **No in town guests are allowed on holidays (Memorial Day, July 4th and Labor Day)**
- Elk's family members must be 16 years of age or older to sign in guests.

Shelter Party Rentals

There is a fee of \$100 for a party that is 2 hours or less (\$125 for 3 hours or less) with a maximum of 20 guests (swimming and/or non-swimming). There is a fee of \$5 per person over the allotted 20 guests. Elk pool members are not counted as guests. **A non-refundable deposit of \$50 is required to reserve the shelter.**

- Please contact the office for availability and reservations at 336-869-7313
- No parties will be allowed on Saturday or Sunday until 12pm.
- No parties are allowed on Memorial Day, July 4th or Labor Day.
- Party/Guests must leave the shelter area when the rental has concluded. Party guests (non-Member) may be asked to leave the pool area if we are near maximum capacity.
