### VEIERANS COMMITTEE

Our Lodge is once again supporting the High Point Heroes Center for the *2024 Veterans Benefits Live* event at the Loft at Congdon Yards. The event will take place Thursday October 17<sup>th</sup> through Saturday the 19<sup>th</sup>.

Last year nearly 550 veterans from 8 states came to High Point to get connected to their VA benefits for the first time, update their claims, or receive a payout. Overall, they had over <u>1,600</u> veterans, their families, and caregivers who were a part of the event. It was truly a life-changing experience to serve them.



Because of the expected large volume of veterans and the logistics of the campus at Congdon Yards, we need more volunteers to help with the following areas:

- Parking cars
- Directing veterans towards the entrance
- Hand out water and maps
- Help direct veterans to the different staging locations inside
- Serve at the snack tables prepared for veterans and their families
- Support the VA staff in guiding and assisting veterans
- Other supportive roles as needed

There will be a 1 hour Zoom meeting prior to the event where they will go over all the roles and processes involved and answer any questions you may have.


